ITEM 6 Information Item: San Diego EnVision Center

San Diego was recently selected as one of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) new EnVision Centers, which offer services in four pillars: economic empowerment, educational advancement, health and wellness, and character and leadership development. The San Diego EnVision Center demonstration program will focus on empowering individuals and families through self-sufficiency and financial self-reliance, with a focus on federal rental assistance recipients, public housing residents, and residents of the San Diego Promise Zone. Speakers from the San Diego Housing Commission and San Diego Workforce Partnership will present an overview of the program, its planned roll-out, partnerships, and goals.
